## **Pre-Op Instructions**

1. Let your Dermatologist know if you are currently taking:
BRILINTA, Coumadin, Pradaxa, Plavix, Aspirin, Fish Oil
DO NOT STOP! The office just needs to be aware.

\*\*If you are taking BRILINTA please notify the office ASAP\*\*

Please also inform the office if you:

- Are on medications for arthritis
- Take antibiotics prior to dental procedures
- Have a heart murmur
- Have a pacemaker/defibrillator
- Have had cardiac bypass surgery or a stroke with in the past 6 months
- Have artificial joint(s) i.e. knee or hip replacement
- 2. Other than the medications listed above and on the reverse, continue all other medications as you normally would prior to surgery.
- 3. Most people drive home following surgery. However, you may wish to have someone with you to drive home.
- 4. Three days prior to surgery, please begin to gently clean the area daily with an antibacterial soap, such as Dial or Lever 2000.
- 5. <u>Shave the area the</u> night before, leaving enough area for bandage following the surgery. If this is a scalp surgery, disregard.
- 6. Call ASAP if you need to cancel your appointment, **508-998-1994**. If after hours leave a message with the answering service.

**Tylenol**- Regular or Extra Strength - **<u>DOES NOT</u>** inhibit your body to form a blood clot and may be taken as needed before and after surgery.
